Times Squares has been invited to provide a square dance demonstration on Thursday, August 10 at 7:30P at Cattyshack in Brooklyn!

Cattyshack, a Brooklyn lesbian and gay bar and dance space, hosts a country dance night twice monthly called "Shitkickers." They give lessons in line dancing and two-stepping and they are very interested in showcasing other styles of dance in the country genre.

Times Squares has been asked to demonstrate there on Thursday, August 10, from approximately 7:30P to 8:15P. Our very own Nick Martellacci will be calling and we will have space enough to put up one square, with spectators surrounding us. While that square is dancing, other members of the club will be able to mingle among the crowd and talk about our upcoming fall mainstream class. This is a great opportunity for Times Squares to reach the lesbian and gay community outside of Manhattan.

Cattyshack is Brooklyn's premier lesbian bar, although it has a highly mixed gay/lesbian/straight crowd and a very eclectic

atmosphere. It is run by the owners of the defunct Meow Mix on Houston. It is located at 249 4th Avenue, between President and Carroll Streets. Cattyshack is directly opposite the 4 line exit at President Street or the R line exit on Union Street, easily accessible from Manhattan or Brooklyn. lot of time square dancing with each other but we had not spent a lot of time naked with each other. It's amazing how comfortable we all felt. fabulous teddy bears. It was all wonderful. The finished photographs were gorgeous and we have sold a lot of calendars.

I must give credit to Daniel. He is an excellent partner in creativity. Witty and focused, Daniel has an incredible eye for detail and is very technologically gifted. And talent runs in the family — it was Daniel's sister, Hope Jason, who designed the calendar, which is professional and polished.

So, thanks to Daniel, Joseph, Julie, Hope and our wonderful models. We have presented gay square dancers, mostly middle-aged, as sexy and cute and oh, so appealing. With Joseph's talented lens we have done our part to focus attention on the allure of the middle-aged. Conventioneers were asking for autographs as our models also doubled as salesman. Thanks must also be given to the Wish Upon A Star hosts for allowing the Times Squares to sell our calendar.
