## December Board Meeting Minutes

Tuesday, December 12, 2006

Meeting called to order by John Nangle at 8:25PM.

**Board Members present:** Bill Wolff, Chaya Levin, Daniel Jason, Frank Frederick, John Nangle, Michael Coan (arrived late), and Vern Calhoun.

**Also present:** Andrew Meyer, Joe Chodash, John Gillen, and Richard Sands.

**1. Board Meeting Minutes:** Minutes taken by Daniel Jason, filling in for Vern Calhoun, for the November Board meeting were accepted and approved 6-0.

**2. Financial Report.** Bill Wolff presented the Financial Report. The Mainstream, Plus and A classes are operating at a loss once the rent from PS 3 is factored in. The C2 class is expected to show a profit. Additionally, the A/C dances continue to show a loss as did the Pre-Turkey Day Combo Dance. Peel the Pumpkin showed a profit, as has the sale of Club calendars.

Nevertheless, the club is in good financial shape with a healthy bank balance. The financial report was approved 6-0.

**3. C1 "Boot Camp":** Andrew Meyer and Vern Calhoun presented an update on the proposal for a weekend-long C1 boot camp to be held in New York City and opened to out-of-town attendees. Without any significant outreach to the Times Squares, there are at least 25 dancers who are interested in the event. The largest problem is booking space for the first weekend in February. Andrew is going to look for a date in March or April when we might have better luck with space. The Board approved going forward with the event with the expectation of breaking even but with the knowledge that a shortfall will be picked up by the club. Vern agreed to contact Dayle Hodge to discuss attendance requirements for the weekend as well as negotiating his fee to be approved by the Board. Pricing is currently contemplated to be between \$95 and \$110 depending on Dayle and the space rental, of which the club has received a \$500 donation earmarked for space. An update will be presented as soon

as new dates have been chosen and Dayle Hodge contacted.

**4. Peel the Pumpkin 2006 review:** Chaya presented a report on Peel the Pumpkin based on the questionnaires returned. The club received high marks across the board for the event, particularly for moving the event out of PS 3, with the exceptions of food in the hotel. Otherwise, the fly-in received excellent scores for everything from callers to baskets to location.

**5. Peel the Pumpkin 2007:** Callers are set for the 2007 fly-in: Anne Uebelacker, Ben Rubright and our own Nick Martellacci. 33 dancers are already registered for 2007, more than the club has had signed up this early in years, even though we do not yet have a location for the fly-in. The Berkeley-Carteret sale has not gone through yet so no deal can be struck until the new owners have closed. The Board was resolute in finding another location outside of NYC and PS 3 should the club not be able to make a deal with the new management of the Berkeley-Carteret.

The Board also discussed the need to have chairs and committees outside the Board that report to the Board on their activities rather than having the Board itself devote as much time as it did this year.

**6. Pricing for the Holiday Dance:** The Board agreed 7-0 to charge the new Mainstream class members \$5 for the Holiday Dance since they would only be able to dance half the time.

**6. Planning for the Annual Meeting:** A location has not been set yet for the January 20, 2007 Annual Meeting. It is anticipated to be at the Center as it was last year, but this has not been confirmed. Michael will be in touch with the Center to firm up our plans. The meeting will be conducted the same as in years back, during the dinner break between the two halves of the Combo Dance with all Board members invited to speak to the assembled membership and with a Q&A to follow. The four new Board members will be announced after the Annual Meeting itself, during the dance, and the

new Executive Committee presented to the membership.

**7. Scholarships:** John Nangle was approved for membership on the Scholarship Committee, which now consists of Michael Coan, Bill Wolff and John. A meeting will be held early in 2007.

There was an Executive session of the Board following the meeting. It is not anticipated that the current Board will meet again prior to the Annual Meeting. If a meeting is necessary, it will take place at PS 3 on Tuesday, January 9.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:54PM.

What is required of you is a long-sleeved black dress shirt. It can be cotton or cotton blend. If unsure about what shirt to buy, please talk with me before you go shopping.

I will prepare and apply front and back applied yokes. This will cost \$25 [not including the cost of the shirt], and lead time of at least two weeks is needed.

The sequin embroidery are heat transfers and some precautions should be heeded.

1. Cold water, hand or gentle wash
2. Hang to air dry
3. Hot iron from the wrong side
4. Never place in the dryer
