1. **Board Meeting Minutes:** Minutes from the May 2006 Board meeting were accepted and approved 6-0.
2. **May Financial Report:** The club is in good fiscal condition. Financial report for May 2006 was presented by Treasurer Bill Wolff and accepted and approved 6-0.
3. **Directory Update:** DaveTorrey has produced the directory, which will be printed and distributed ASAP. Directories will initially be distributed at dances. Rick Massi will provide a mailing list from which Dave can check off who gets the directories. Dave will mail the balance of

Daniel has completed the survey. Based on the results, the club will offer Mainstream, Plus and A1/2 in the fall. There is enough interest to hold a C2 class if someone wants to come forward to organize it.

### 6. Outreach-Inreach Committees:

Suggestions for outreach and inreach will be brought by each Board member to the next meeting with the hope of maximizing the opportunities we have related to the open houses in the fall. It is important to remember that active outreach and inreach committees are what keep prices of classes and dances down. Volunteers are needed to help these efforts.

7. **Space:** Friday June 9's A2/C1 dance was the second dance at the new space, the Empire Dance Studio on West 25th Street. Bill reported the lasA/C dance still fell short on attendance to make the space break even—three squares are needed to do that. If we cannot get more people to turn out for the dances, we will have to find another space or consider canceling them. The Board strongly encourages members to turn out in full force for the next A/C dance on Friday, July 14.

8. **Peterson Fund:** Daniel will apply for a grant to cover caller fees, printing and space for the fall open houses.

9. **Club Calendar Update:** The calendar has been completed and is at the printers. Copies will be shipped to LA for the convention when printing is completed on June 23.

10. **Changes in Election Procedures:** The Board discussed suggestions made by the Election Committee earlier in the year about how elections are conducted, including election deadlines, and the size of the Board. The Committee's suggestions would require a change to the by-laws, which in turn require a majority vote by the membership. Vern is to propose language to the Board at its next meeting for changing the by-laws to accommodate some of the requests.

11. The next Board meeting will be on Monday, July 17 at 7:30P at FIT. Board meeting was adjourned at 9:58PM.
